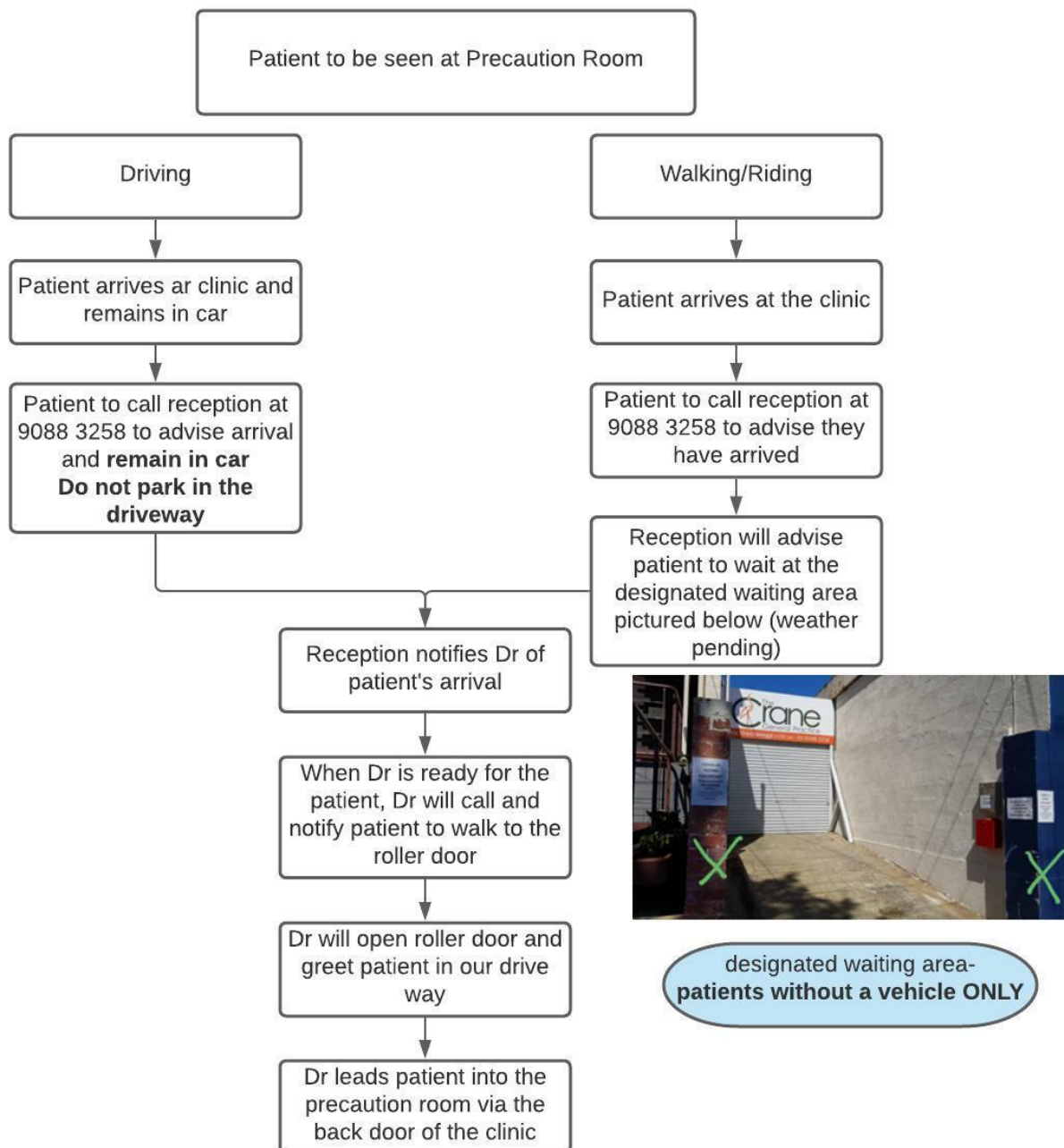


Your doctor has assessed that you should be seen in our precaution room due to potential infection risk.

We strongly advise that if you have a car, please drive here for your appointment. This means that you can isolate in your car while waiting for your appointment, without putting others at risk of contracting your illness.

Please refer to the following map:



**Patient is to remain in car at all times until called by Dr.
Please DO NOT park in the driveway which is a 24-hour thoroughfare.**

Please bring along:

- Your mobile phone
- A form of identification e.g. Your Medicare card, driver's licence, passport or student ID
- Your face covering

Do not enter via the front door

The front door is for patients who do not pose an infection risk.

What happens at my appointment?

Your appointment will be conducted in a seemingly bare room for the sake of infection control.

Your doctor will be dressed in full Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).

You will be examined accordingly, and given clinical advice on how to manage your illness.

The room, furniture and equipment will be disinfected once the consultation has ended.
