



Nurse Fee for Nurse-Only Appointments

From Monday 7 July 2025, a nurse fee of **\$20** will be charged for most nurse-only appointments to cover our nurses' time. Complex nurse appointments will incur higher fees depending on the length of your consultation. Please note there is no Medicare rebate for all nurse fees.

Items 10997/10987 (or phone equivalent)

Nurse will BB 10997/10987 for all eligible patients:

- CDM review appts (NOT CDM New)
- Rev in person LONG or SHORT appts
- FLU shot appts
- Infectious appts
- Phone follow-ups requested by GPs or patients – ie Nurse to advise, COVID follow up, enquiry about vaccinations/injections
